Connect to the Room System To show content on the dispay(s): Connect the provided HDMI cable or USB-C cable to your device To access the room's camera and microphone for video conferencing: Connect the provided USB-A cable to your device OR Select and use the Room PC on display 2 To access the room's speakers to play audio: Crestron (HD Audio Driver for Display Audio)

The camera tab allows you to preview and control cameras manually

The mics tab allows you to adjust individual volume and mute/unmute mics

Select **Crestron** as the system audio output on your device

The utilities tab allows access to:

- Display power
- Screen control
- Show video
- HDCP control

Push either power symbol to turn the system off

The menu tab allows you to navigate to different pages of the touch panel

When a device is connected using the provided cables, "Laptop" will automatically be selected on Display 1

Display 2 must be manually selected

Volume control for the selected source

The source tab allows you to select a source to be displayed

Audio will play from the last selected source, indicated by the highlighted music note

Shows the current state of the in-room display
If off is selected, content is still being captured in a Classroom Capture recording
